Dear Parent/carers,

I am writing to confirm arrangements for the rest of the week.

Friday 26th June

The weather forecast for Friday is now predicting temperatures similar to those we are expecting tomorrow, and the Met Office has extended the Amber warning to include Friday.

Therefore on Friday we will have the same arrangements as we have had in place this week, pupils do not have to wear a tie and blazer and are allowed to wear PE kit if they choose. The usual Heathland PE kit requirements still apply. I should emphasise please that this does not include 'crocs' or 'sliders'.

Therefore pupils should wear either the adapted summer uniform or full PE kit.

On Friday 26th June, **all pupils will be dismissed from school at 12.50pm.** Pupils will be set work to complete for the afternoon lessons that are cancelled. There will be no afterschool detentions.

Lunch will be available for pupils if they wish to stay on site to eat at lunchtime.

Monday 29th June until the end of term (Wednesday 22nd July)

We will revert to our usual school timings from Monday 29th June.

However we will continue to permit pupils to wear 'summer uniform'. This means that **pupils will be required to wear their usual school uniform, including their lanyard, but do not have to wear their tie or blazer** if they choose not to. PE kit must not be worn to school from Monday onwards.

My thanks for your understanding with these arrangements, we are committed to keeping everyone healthy and safe during these extreme temperatures.
