

Using Mathletics and Spellodrome

All students have access to these two online sites that have been proved to be most effective at increasing progress and attainment in both mathematics and English. We have attached a number of PDF guides to help you and also created this quick overview of the basics. Don't forget to sign up for your free **Parent account** (details below).

Basic use of Mathletics

- Students gain points by completing tasks and answering questions correctly
- Students gain Gold bars by completing at least 85% of a task correctly
- If a student manages to get 1000 points within a week (Monday-Sunday) they will receive a certificate
- Students are expected to complete tasks until they get a Gold, they can access these by clicking the pie chart at the bottom left of the screen

Basic use of Spellodrome

- Click on “My Word List” and then a list and a word to test whether you can spell all the words on your list
- Click on “My Results” to review the words that you can spell correctly or need to improve. If you click on a word that you need to improve upon you will need to re-spell it 3 times to remove it from the list
- Occasionally teachers will set you assessments to complete to test your spelling
- There are various spelling games to try out
- “Writing Fun” gives you different writing frames and advice for various situations
