Candidates can choose to participate as a player/performer, official/referee or leader/coach for two of their assessments. However they can be assessed as a player/performer for all three assessments if this suits.

Candidates are assessed for Key Process A, B and C

Key Process A

Ability to perform basic skills/techniques in practise situations.

Key Process B

Effectiveness in a game situation, including tactical and positional awareness.

Key Process C

Ability to evaluate their own or others performance.

Activities undertaken outside the direct supervision of the centre must have DVD evidence of the performance.
