Prohibited uses

You also agree not to access without authority, interfere with, damage or disrupt:

- any part of our Website;
- any equipment or network on which our site is stored;
- any software used in the provision of our Website; or
- any equipment or network or software owned or used by any third party.

You confirm that you are lawfully able to input the test results for any person that you register test results on behalf of regarding the Covid-19 testing in respect of your school's or institution's relevant Covid-19 testing programme.

Breach of this policy

When we consider that a breach of this policy has occurred, we may take such action as we deem appropriate.

Failure to comply with this policy constitutes a material breach of the terms of use of our Website upon which you are permitted to use our site, and may result in our taking all or any of the following actions:

- Immediate, temporary or permanent withdrawal of your right to use our Website.
- Issue of a warning to you.
- Legal proceedings against you for reimbursement of all costs on an indemnity basis (including, but not limited to, reasonable administrative and legal costs) resulting from the breach.
